<u>Samson</u> - Destined For Greatness

But...

Judges 13:1-25

Samson was the Strongest man who ever lived, yet was also the Weakest.

Samson's life reveals the Sad Consequences of demanding your Own Way.

Samson is a Good <u>Example</u> of what a <u>Believer</u> should <u>NOT</u> be. (James 1:8)

Let's begin by looking at the <u>DETAILS</u> surrounding the <u>BIRTH</u> of Samson.

1. THE <u>ANNOUNCEMENT</u> OF SAMSON'S BIRTH. (vv.1-5)

- Notice. It Came As A HEAVENLY Announcement.
- This "Angel of the Lord" is a Pre-Bethlehem, Pre-incarnate Appearance of the Lord Jesus Christ. (another "Christophany" {Chap. 6})
- It Also Came As A <u>HOPEFUL</u> Announcement.
- God <u>ALWAYS</u> has a <u>PLAN</u> to Revive & Restore His people.

2. THE <u>ARRANGEMENTS</u> OF SAMSON'S BIRTH. (vv. 6-14)

- These Arrangements Involved A MIRACLE. (God Sent a BABY)
- You may <u>Think</u> no one <u>Cares</u> about <u>YOU</u> or what you're <u>Facing</u> but <u>God in Heaven</u> has His eye on <u>YOU</u>...(Matthew 10:29-31)
- These Arrangements Also Involved A MANDATE. ("WOMB to the TOMB")
- When the Lord <u>Saved</u> US, He <u>Purchased</u> US, we're <u>His Property</u> & we're to <u>Be Separated</u> "unto" the Lord.
- The Arrangements of His Birth Also Involved A MINISTRY.
- Parents, you just Never Know Who God is calling you to RAISE.

3. THE ACCOMPLISHMENT OF SAMSON'S BIRTH. (vv.15-25)

- The REALIZATION Of Samson's Birth. (v.24a)
- God ALWAYS <u>Keeps</u> His <u>Promises!</u>
- Sometimes we can **Do our Best** & our children may **still NOT <u>Turn</u> Out** as we had hoped.
- The <u>RELATIONSHIP</u> Of His Birth. (v. 24b)
- "the Spirit of the Lord began to Move upon him..."

- How sad it is *When <u>WE Fail</u> to <u>Live Up</u> to our <u>Potential</u> in the Lord!! <u>OUR Duty</u> is to Be <u>Where</u> God wants us, <u>Doing What</u> He wants us to do.*
- What does <u>YOUR</u> <u>Relationship</u> with the <u>Lord</u> look like? Christian, What does <u>YOUR</u> <u>Relationship</u> with the <u>Holy</u> <u>Spirit</u> look like?
