## The Cost Of Biblical Excellence Galatians 2:20; Philippians

2:13

Like Ruth, we should ALL <u>Strive</u> to reach this <u>GOAL</u> of Biblical Excellence by <u>Reflecting</u> God's Character & <u>Becoming</u> Like Christ...(Ruth 3:11)

But this Lofty Goal of Biblical Excellence comes with a COST TO YOU...

- 1. BIBLICAL EXCELLENCE IS ROOTED IN SURRENDER. (Gal. 2:20; John 3:30)
- Whatever **Religious or Spiritual knowledge** you have is **USELESS IF** it **does NOT Lead** you to a **REAL** & **ONGOING Practice** of **Surrender**.
- The greatest opposition to you becoming Biblical Excellent... is <u>SELF</u>.
- Galatians 2:20 gives US the CONDITION For Surrender: DEATH
- It also gives US the <u>RESULT</u> Of Surrender...A <u>LIFE</u> OF <u>FAITH</u>
- There are *Three Attitudes* at work in *Luke 9:23* regarding *Surrender*.
- "Deny himself" reminds us to say "NO" to Oneself in order to say "YES" to God!!
- "Taking up your Cross Daily" reminds us to <u>Endure Whatever</u> is necessary to <u>LIVE</u> how God wants us to <u>LIVE</u>.
- "Follow Me" reminds us the Christian life is a <u>Moment by Moment Decision</u> to surrender to the <u>life of Christ</u>.
- 2. BIBLICAL EXCELLENCE IS REFLECTED IN <u>OBEDIENCE</u>. (Philippians 2:13)
- To make an <u>Impact</u>...to be <u>Biblically Excellent</u>...we must <u>Prove</u> that we <u>POSSESS</u> that which we <u>PROFESS</u>.
- God desires that <u>Our Obedience</u> be <u>Motivated</u> by <u>Our Love</u> for Him...
- Obeying Is For OUR Good! (Deut. 10:12-13)
- What is **YOUR ATTITUDE** toward **Obedience?** (Luke 6:46-49)
- It's always <u>OUR CHOICE</u> to either <u>Obey</u> God or <u>Disobey</u> God.
- Do you "WILL" to <u>DO</u> the will of God?
- Do you "WILL" to KNOW the will of God?
- More than anything, for our <u>OWN</u> <u>Benefit</u>...God desires that we <u>Grow</u> & <u>Become Like</u> <u>Christ</u> in our <u>ATTITUDE</u> toward <u>Obedience</u>. (Philippians 2:5-8)
- To Become Biblically Excellent, YOU must <u>CHOOSE</u> to live Totally <u>Surrendered</u> & Fully <u>Obedient</u> to God.
