# Thanking God Through Adversity 1 Thessalonians 5:12-23

We always find it **EASY** to Thank God when everything is Going **GOOD**...

However, During Times of Adversity ...it's HARDER to Be Thankful.

Yet the Bible clearly <u>Teaches</u> we are to <u>Be Thankful</u> even in BAD Times.

# 1. GOD MAY BE USING ADVERSITY TO GET OUR ATTENTION.

- (Acts 9:1-6; Daniel 4:30-34)
- We can Safely <u>Assume</u> that <u>EVERY time</u> we're going through a Major <u>Trial</u>, God is trying to <u>Get our Attention</u> in some fashion.
- When we **go through <u>Trials</u>**, we are <u>Forced</u> to <u>Look</u> to <u>GOD</u> for deliverance. (Psalm 121:1-2)

# 2. GOD MAY BE USING ADVERSITY TO DRAW US <u>NEARER</u> TO HIM.

- In Trials, God Breaks OUR independent Spirit in order to Draw Us close to Him.
- "In the Day of <u>Prosperity</u> we have <u>Many Places</u> to run for safety but in the Day of <u>Adversity</u> we have <u>ONE</u>." (1 Peter 5:6-7)
- Through all Adversity, **we can Choose to <u>Rejoice</u>**. (Psalm 18:6)

## 3. GOD MAY BE USING ADVERSITY TO STRENGTHEN US.

- God does not allow us to endure bad times to <u>Destroy</u> us, but to <u>Discipline</u> us.
- Could God just ELIMINATE the Adversity? ... YEP, He Sure Could!
- "Our <u>Strength</u> only <u>Increases</u> in proportion to the <u>Burdens</u> placed on it." (Colossians 1:11)
- "If adversity's ready to <u>Strike</u>, God's ready to <u>Strengthen</u>"

# 4. GOD MAY BE USING ADVERSITY TO <u>REFINE</u> US. (Prov. 25:4 Isaiah 1:25)

- Decisions & Actions have Consequences. (Psalm 119:71-72)
- JOB knew a little about <u>Intense Seasons</u> of Adversity. (Job 23:10)
- A person is not <u>Made PURE without adversity</u>.

### GOD MAY BE USING ADVERSITY TO MAKE US A BLESSING.

- God's ultimate <u>Purpose</u> is to <u>Rescue</u> lost souls in danger of <u>Damnation</u>. (Phil 1:12)
- We Never Know what route God may Use to make us a Blessing to others. (Genesis 50:20)
- Could God be using your Adversity to BLESS OTHER PEOPLE?
