# Would You Call Yourself A Committed Christian? James 1:22-27

HOW do we TELL the <u>Difference</u> who is <u>Committed</u> & who's <u>NOT</u>?

How RELIGIOUS are YOU?

The Bible says if you're <u>Religious</u> in regards to your <u>Commitment</u> to Christ, you'll be Committed in at least <u>FOUR</u> <u>WAYS</u>...

# 1. IF YOU'RE COMMITTED, YOU'LL LISTEN & DO THE WORD. (22-25)

- We can't Hear the <u>Physical Voice</u> of Jesus, but we <u>SIT in front</u> of His Word, <u>KNEEL</u> before Him in Prayer & <u>LISTEN</u> for our Master's Voice.
- Do YOU <u>REALLY Listen</u> when God's Word is <u>PREACHED</u>?
- How you can <u>Tell</u> if you're a <u>Good Listener</u> to God's Word: "Be <u>Doers</u> Of The Word!"
- If you're <u>Committed</u> to <u>Christ</u>...you'll <u>DO</u> <u>something!</u>

# 2. IF YOU'RE COMMITTED, YOU'LL WATCH YOUR TONGUE. (26)

- One of the Hardest Things in the world to do is to Keep our Mouths Shut...(v.26)
- The <u>Best Way for the Believer</u> is to: <u>Take it to the Lord in PRAYER!</u>
- You can't just Blurt it out then ask Forgiveness
- If you're Committed to Christ ...you'll Watch your Tongue

### 3. IF YOU'RE COMMITTED, YOU'LL MINISTER TO THOSE IN DISTRESS.

- You don't have to look <u>Very Far</u> to find <u>Young People</u> who need A <u>Godly Influence</u> or Distressed <u>Elderly Folks</u> who could really use a <u>kind word</u>. (v.27a)
- Don't Miss Out on <u>Ministering</u> to People, Young or Old, that God wants to <u>Bless</u> through YOU.
- If you're <u>Committed</u> to Christ... you'll <u>Minister</u> to those in Distress!

### 4. IF YOU'RE COMMITTED, YOU'LL KEEP YOURSELF CLEAN. (v.27b)

- The World's Pollution is Everywhere.
- Worshiping Anything MORE than God is IDOLATRY. (Romans 1:25; 2 Timothy 3:1-2; 1 John 2:15)
- When we Repeatedly Choose Christ over Contamination, He'll keep us Clean! (v.27b)
- To be Committed to Christ... we must put our <u>FAITH IN ACTION</u>.
