

One Thing God Can't Forgive

Matthew 12:22-32

Most all the sins written in the Bible share One Similarity...God **FORGAVE** them.

Today, we Deal with a Passage known as the "Unforgivable" or "Unpardonable" Sin.

Only ONE sin is called Unforgivable..."Blasphemy of the Holy Spirit."

1. THE MIRACLE JESUS PERFORMED. (vv.22-23)

- Many were Amazed & Wondered if Jesus was the Long-Awaited Savior.
- The Pharisees Accused Jesus of being someone Completely Different...

2. THE REACTION OF THE PHARISEES. (v.24)

- They could NOT Deny His POWER, so, they Question the SOURCE of his Power.
- They basically said Jesus Accomplished those Miracles through the power of Satan.
- DID the Pharisees Commit the Unpardonable Sin?

3. THE RESPONSE OF JESUS. (vv.25-30)

- Jesus Charges Them With Being ILLOGICAL. (v.26)
- Jesus Charges Them With Being INCONSISTENT. (v.27)
- Jesus Makes This IMPLICATION. (vv. 28-29)
- "Jesus Enters Satan's dominion, Binds him & Frees his helpless Victims."
- Jesus gives US a REMINDER. (v.30) ... You Can't be NEUTRAL!

4. THE REAL MEANING OF THE UNFORGIVABLE SIN. (vv.31-32)

- This is one of the most Misunderstood & Feared passages in the whole Bible.
- What the Unpardonable Sin is NOT.
- The Unpardonable Sin is NOT Murder, Sexual Immorality, Adultery, Divorce, Denying Christ or even Suicide...

• WHAT IS this Unpardonable Sin ("Blasphemy of the Holy Spirit")?

• It is the Ongoing, Continual Rejection of the Witness of God's Holy Spirit to FACT that JESUS is the Savior.

• While there is NO SIN God will NOT FORGIVE... THERE IS a DEADLINE.

• If the Holy Spirit is Tugging at your heart...you need to Respond.

• Jesus may Return TODAY...
