## Thriving In Turbulent Times Don't Disconnect, Stay Connected! Hebrews 10:19-25

The Very <u>Best Place</u> for a Christian to be <u>Encouraged</u>, <u>Built Up</u> & <u>Motivated</u>, EVEN in Turbulent Times, is with the <u>Body</u> of <u>Christ</u>.

When we <u>Gather Together</u>, we get the <u>Lord's Attention</u>. (Malachi 3:16)

When we <u>Gather Together</u>, the LORD Promises to <u>Participate</u>. (Matthew 18:20)

"Staying Connected" in the Body of Christ is the best way to Thrive in Turbulent Times.

## "STAYING CONNECTED" IS IMPERATIVE.

- Early Believers made Gathering Together a PRIORITY.
- They **Connected** With Believers **At CHURCH**. (Acts 2:46a; 2 Thessalonians 2:1)
- They Connected With Believers In HOMES. (Acts 2:46b)
- There's a Bible <u>Imperative</u> for <u>Believers</u> to "<u>Gather Together</u>" both <u>Corporately AND</u> in a Small Group Setting.

## "STAYING CONNECTED" IS IMPORTANT.

- WHY is Staying Connected with the Body of Christ SO IMPORTANT?
- The Body of Christ **Promotes <u>LOVE</u>**. (v.24; John 13:34, Gal. 5:13, Heb. 3:13, James 5:16)
- The Body of Christ Provokes GOOD WORKS. (Ephesians 2:8-10)
- The Body of Christ Provides ENCOURAGEMENT.

## "STAYING CONNECTED" IS INCENTIVIZED.

- There is a Definite <u>UPSIDE</u> for <u>Staying Connected</u> to the Body of Christ.
- Some Christians had Stopped Meeting Together ("as is the manner of some")
- The <u>CLOSER</u> we get to the **Day of Christ's <u>Return</u>**, the <u>MORE</u> we should be <u>Gathering</u> <u>Together & Preparing</u> ourselves to Meet Him...<u>NOT LESS</u>.
- We are <u>Closer</u> to the Lord's Return TODAY than we were Yesterday.
- Our <u>Commitment</u> to "<u>Stay Connected</u>" should <u>Be Stronger</u> in light of His Return.
