HOW does Jesus Feel about Believers who REFUSE to Be Committed? (Revelation 3:14-15)

We MUST <u>BE</u> <u>PREPARED</u>!

We must <u>STAY Centered</u> on Christ, <u>Confident</u> in His Word, <u>Connected</u> to His Church, <u>Compassionate</u> to Others & above all, <u>Committed</u> to the Faith.

1. THE LORD'S INSTRUCTION ABOUT COMMITMENT.

- <u>Patience</u> Humbly <u>Accepts</u> all things Knowing God is ultimately <u>Orchestrating</u> all things for the **Believer's** <u>Good</u>. (v.7a)
- Difficult Circumstances Help Us FOCUS on What's Most Important.
- Difficult Circumstances is the <u>Only Place</u> we NEED <u>Patience</u>, therefore it's the <u>Only</u> <u>Place</u> we LEARN <u>Patience</u>.
- God allows Difficult Circumstances only Long Enough to get Our Priorities in Order.

2. THE LORD'S ILLUSTRATION ABOUT COMMITMENT.

- Farmers then, like today had <u>No Control</u> over the rain, they just had to <u>WAIT</u>. (v.7b)
- We have <u>NO Control</u> over the <u>RETURN</u> of Christ Either.
- <u>Think</u> about **Those who <u>Waited</u>** for the <u>1st</u> <u>COMING</u> of Christ.
- Peter said, "<u>Scoffers</u> will come in the <u>Last Days</u>." (2 Peter 3:3, 8-9)
- To Measure <u>God's Activity</u> on a <u>Human Timetable</u> is <u>ABSURD</u>.

3. THE LORD'S IMPLICATION ABOUT COMMITMENT.

- <u>Two things</u> we can <u>Expect</u> to Happen when we Stay <u>Patiently</u> Committed to the Lord.
- We Develop <u>CONFIDENCE</u> As We WAIT. (v.8)
- We have a Confident Faith in our Lord who has All the Answers We Don't.
- We Develop <u>COURAGE</u> As We WAIT.
- Because we have <u>Confidence</u> that He's <u>Coming</u>, we also have <u>Courage to Face</u> <u>Whatever</u> Comes BEFORE He Gets Here!
- <u>GOD WINS</u>!
