Thriving In Turbulent Times Don't Be Lukewarm, Be Committed! James 5:7-8

HOW does Jesus Feel about Believers who REFUSE to Be Committed? (Revelation 3:14-15)

We MUST BE PREPARED!

We must <u>STAY</u> <u>Centered</u> on Christ, <u>Confident</u> in His Word, <u>Connected</u> to His Church, <u>Compassionate</u> to Others & above all, <u>Committed</u> to the Faith.

1. THE LORD'S <u>INSTRUCTION</u> ABOUT COMMITMENT.

- <u>Patience Humbly Accepts</u> all things Knowing God is ultimately <u>Orchestrating</u> all things for the <u>Believer's Good</u>. (v.7a)
- Difficult Circumstances Help Us <u>FOCUS</u> on What's <u>Most Important</u>.
- **Difficult Circumstances** is the **Only Place** we **NEED Patience**, therefore it's the **Only Place** we **LEARN Patience**.
- God allows Difficult Circumstances only Long Enough to get Our Priorities in Order.

2. THE LORD'S ILLUSTRATION ABOUT COMMITMENT.

- Farmers then, like today had No Control over the rain, they just had to WAIT. (v.7b)
- We have NO Control over the RETURN of Christ Either.
- <u>Think</u> about <u>Those who <u>Waited</u> for the <u>1st</u> <u>COMING</u> of Christ.
 </u>
- Peter said, "Scoffers will come in the Last Days." (2 Peter 3:3, 8-9)
- To Measure God's Activity on a Human Timetable is ABSURD.

3. THE LORD'S IMPLICATION ABOUT COMMITMENT.

- <u>Two things</u> we can <u>Expect</u> to Happen when we Stay <u>Patiently</u> <u>Committed</u> to the Lord.
- We Develop CONFIDENCE As We WAIT. (v.8)
- We have a Confident Faith in our Lord who has All the Answers We Don't.
- We Develop COURAGE As We WAIT.
- Because we have <u>Confidence</u> that <u>He's Coming</u>, we also have <u>Courage</u> to <u>Face</u> <u>Whatever</u> Comes BEFORE He Gets Here!
