A Proper View Of The Future James 4:13-17

MISTAKE 1: PLANNING YOUR FUTURE WITHOUT GOD. (v.13)

- They were Guilty of Indifference toward GOD.
- They Had a <u>PLAN</u> that was Constructed, Chosen, Calculated, Considered & Computed.
- Their <u>PROBLEM</u> was <u>Two-Fold</u>: They Carried out their <u>Lives</u> & Planned their <u>Future</u> Without GOD.
- "Man Proposes, but God <u>Disposes!"</u>

MISTAKE 2: PRESUMING TO KNOW THE FUTURE. (vv.14-16)

- They Failed To Comprehend The COMPLEXITY of Life.
- They Failed To Comprehend the <u>UNCERTAINTY</u> of Life.
- They Failed To Comprehend The <u>BREVITY</u> of Life. (Luke 12:15-19)

MISTAKE 3: POSTPONING TODAY'S WORK 'TIL TOMORROW. (v.17)

- Procrastination is NOTHING NEW. (Exodus 7-9; Proverbs 3:27-28; Deut. 15:7, 10-11)
- Putting Off What we KNOW we should DO NOW is the Sin of Omission. (Luke 12:47-48)
- Tomorrow may Never Come...
- Things Go Better With GOD...
- Let us Not be found Guilty of the Sin of Pride, Presumption or Procrastination.
