More Than An Overcomer

Luke 4:1-13

IN THIS <u>CORNER</u>...he's known as "Your <u>Adversary</u>, a <u>Roaring Lion</u>, "cunning as a <u>Serpent</u>" & "a <u>Murderer</u> from the beginning of time."

IN THIS <u>CORNER</u>...He's known as "the <u>LAMB</u> of God," "The <u>WAY</u>, the <u>TRUTH</u> & the <u>LIFE</u>," "the <u>Messiah</u>, <u>Christ</u> & the <u>Savior</u> of the world."

Through this Heavyweight Bout, <u>WE</u> can Learn HOW to <u>OVERCOME</u> Temptations the Devil Throws our way...

1. SITUATIONS SATAN USES TO TEMPT US.

- The Temptation of Jesus came <u>AFTER</u> He was <u>BAPTIZED</u>.
- The Lord's Baptism gave APPROVAL to John's Ministry.
- The Lord's Baptism <u>IDENTIFIED</u> Him with Sinners.
- The Lord's Baptism was a <u>PICTURE</u> How He'd Save Us.
- This Temptation came at Time of Physical <u>WEAKNESS</u>.
- This Temptation came to Jesus When He was ALONE.

2. STRATEGIES SATAN USES TO TEMPT US.

- The Devil can't MAKE (Force) YOU do ANYTHING.
- He is Successful because he <u>Uses</u> Tried & True <u>STRATEGIES</u> of tempting us.
- FIRST...he LAYS out the BAIT...
- SECOND...COMES the APPEAL...
- THIRD...the STRUGGLE BEGINS...
- FOURTH...the Temptation ENDS with a RESPONSE...Swim away or Swallow it whole.

3. THE SIGNIFICANCE OF JESUS' TEMPTATIONS.

- The Holy Spirit "PROVED" Christ...the devil tried to "LURE HIM to do Evil."
- LIKE US, Jesus could be <u>Tempted</u> from "<u>WITHOUT</u>" all day long.
- BUT UNLIKE US, Jesus Could NOT be Tempted from "WITHIN."
- Jesus Could be "ENTICED" to Sin BUT it was Morally Impossible for Him "to YIELD" to those Temptations.
- The Sole <u>PURPOSE</u> of the <u>Temptations</u> was <u>NOT to see <u>IF</u> He would Sin, but to <u>PROVE</u> that even under <u>Tremendous <u>Pressure</u></u> He could <u>Do Nothing</u> but <u>OBEY the Word of God</u>.
