This <u>Message</u> is for the <u>WHOLE</u> <u>Church</u>.

3 Types of <u>Servants</u> we find in the church.

1. GENERAL SERVANTS.

- The <u>Original</u> Bible word for <u>Deacon</u> (<u>diakonos</u>) is most often translated as <u>Servant</u>. (John 2:5, John 12:2, Luke 4:39)
- See What <u>Jesus</u> Did with the word <u>Servant</u>. (John 12:26)
- None of us are <u>SAVED</u> to <u>SIT</u>...we're all <u>SAVED</u> to <u>SERVE!</u>

2. GIFTED SERVANTS. (Romans 12:5-8)

- Characteristics of a Gifted Servant:
- They are <u>Alert</u> & <u>Aware</u> of Practical <u>Needs</u>
- They are <u>Motivated</u> to Meet Needs <u>Quickly</u>.
- They <u>Meet Needs</u> Despite Personal <u>Weariness</u>.
- They <u>Complete</u> a <u>Job</u> once it is Been <u>Started</u>.

3. MODEL SERVANTS.

- God is Really BIG on the idea Being an EXAMPLE.
- Deacons are called to be <u>EXAMPLES</u> in "<u>EVERY</u>" <u>Way</u>.
- Deacons <u>Compel</u> themselves to be <u>Christians ABOVE REPROACH</u>.
- <u>Deacons</u>, you are being <u>Called</u> upon, <u>NOT</u> to be <u>Perfect</u>, but to <u>Strive</u> to be the <u>MODELS</u>...MODEL <u>SERVANTS</u>...
- Because of this **Awesome Responsibility**, the **Bible Calls upon us** to **LAY HANDS upon you** & **PRAY for you**.
