

“You Play, You Pay”

The Consequences of Sin

Psalms 51:1-17

If we're Saved, Does that Mean we have Nothing to LOSE When we SIN?

David looks back on the Consequences of his SIN After he got his Heart Right with God.

1. SIN DIRTIES THE SOUL. (v.2)

- The True Child of God Realizes he's DIRTY when he sins & he feels COMPELLED to DO Something about it!

2. SIN DOMINATES THE MIND. (v.3)

- If you're a Born-Again child of God, His Holy Spirit will NOT let you IGNORE Ongoing Sin

3. SIN DISGRACES THE LORD. (v.4)

- David SAW his Sin for What it WAS – a Slandering Offense Against our HOLY GOD!
- It Dawned on David, “My God YOU were Watching me...YOUR eyes Saw what I did.”

4. SIN DEPRESSES THE HEART. (vv.8, 12)

- The Most Miserable Person is one who is SAVED but OUT of Fellowship with God.
- A person is NOT Made up of their ACTIONS, their Reactions are what they REALLY Are.
- HAPPINESS Tells what happens...JOY Controls what happens.

5. SIN DISEASES THE BODY. (v.8)

- When a Believer SINS, God doesn't Toss us out, He Squeezes us More.
- A Sinful Mind & Spirit can make the BODY Sick.

6. SIN DEFILES THE SPIRIT. (v.10)

- You can Always TELL when a Person is BACKSLIDING...they Get a CRITICAL Spirit.
- BACKSLIDERS often have a Sour, Vile Spirit while Finding Fault in everyone else

7. SIN DESTROYS TESTIMONY. (vv.14-15)

- David's Tongue is NOT Singing...His Mouth is NOT Praising & he's NOT Leading Anyone to God.
- Something INSIDE was NOT RIGHT.
- IF you're Bound Up in SIN, you're Bound to SUFFER...
