

Avoiding Lukewarm Christianity

Romans 1:14-17

When Paul MET Jesus, he asked Two Greatest Questions:
WHO are You Lord? WHAT would You have me to DO?

WHAT Transformed Paul into the Greatest Missionary the world has ever known?

Paul says, “I AM” Three Times...

If YOU can SAY these 3 Things ...YOU can AVOID Lukewarm Christianity.

1. PAUL WAS FAITHFUL TO THE OBLIGATIONS OF THE GOSPEL. (v.14)

- To WHOM or To WHAT was Paul *in debt*?
- Paul was *in Debt to CHRIST* (v.1)
- Paul saw himself *Indebted to his fellow CHRISTIANS* (v.8)
- Paul saw himself as a Debtor to the COMMUNITY (v.14)

2. PAUL WAS FLEXIBLE FOR THE OPPORTUNITIES OF THE GOSPEL. (v.15)

- The Problem with most of US is if God were to Speak to us, we're NOT READY to ROLL.
- Paul says, “as much as is in me,” that means NOT with a Lukewarm Attitude.
- Many say they're READY to “DIE for Jesus” but are READY to LIVE for Jesus?
- Paul was READY to LIVE...READY to DIE...READY to GO.

3. PAUL WAS FEARLESS OF THE OPPOSITION TO THE GOSPEL. (v.16)

- Paul declared, “I am NOT ASHAMED of the Gospel of Christ.” ARE YOU?
- Paul was NOT ASHAMED of the PERSON of the Gospel. (v.16a)
- Paul was NOT ASHAMED of the PURPOSE of the Gospel. (v.16b)
- Paul was NOT ASHAMED of the PLAN of the Gospel. (v.16c)
- The World's Religions are spelled D-O...Ours is spelled D-O-N-E... “It is Finished”
- Everybody you SEE & KNOW is either SAVED or LOST.
