Cornerstones Of Faith "Provision"

2 Corinthians 9:6-11

Jesus wants to be LORD & In Command of EVERY aspect of your life.

When we Allow God to PROVIDE for His work <u>Through US</u>, we will be making an investment with <u>Eternal Dividends</u>.

Today, we ask FOUR QUESTIONS about our 12th Cornerstone of Faith - PROVISION

- 1. WHY SHOULD I GIVE A PORTION OF MY MONEY? (2 Corinthians 9:6-11)
- GOD wants to PROVE HIS Faithful Provision through YOUR Regular Giving.
- "God will Generously Provide all you need...with plenty Left Over to Share with others."
- "YOU will be <u>Enriched</u> in every way so YOU can always be <u>Generous</u>"
- In Times of Uncertainty, Our <u>Faithfulness</u> in God's <u>Provision</u> is Truly <u>Tested</u>...
- 2. <u>HOW MUCH AM I TO GIVE? (Mark 12:41-44)</u>
- Generosity is NOT Measured by the SIZE of the gift, but by its MOTIVE.
- God doesn't want your <u>LEFTOVERS!</u>
- Our Attitude toward Giving should be like the Believers in Macedonia. (2 Cor. 8:3-4)

3. WHAT HAPPENS WHEN I GIVE?

- Our MOTIVES Are Perfected.
- As We Give, God Will Give To US. (Luke 6:38)
- OTHERS Are Helped From Our Financial Giving.
- When you <u>Give</u> to the <u>Lord's work</u>, that <u>Money</u>, which really <u>HAD <u>ZERO Spiritual Impact</u> <u>BEFORE</u>, <u>NOW</u> is used to <u>Touch</u> the lives of people for the <u>Glory of God</u>.
 </u>

4. HOW SHOULD I <u>VIEW MATERIAL WEALTH?</u> (Matthew 6:19-34)

- We Must **Watch <u>WHAT</u> & <u>HOW</u> WE <u>STORE</u>. (Matthew 6:19)**
- We Must Keep Our VISION CLEAR. (Matthew 6:24)
- We Should <u>NOT WORRY</u> About Material Things. (Matthew 6:27)
- We Must Put GOD FIRST, Especially In Our GIVING. (Matthew 6:33)

5. AM I FREE TO <u>ENJOY</u> WEALTH? (1 Timothy 6:6-19)

- IF He does bless you with material things, He <u>REQUIRES THREE THINGS</u> of you:
- 1.) Don't Put Your <u>HOPE</u> In Your Wealth. (v.10)
- 2.) ENJOY What God Has Given You. (v.17b)
- 3.) Be <u>GENEROUS</u>, Do <u>GOOD</u> & <u>SHARE</u> Your Wealth With Others. (v.18)

•	If God <u>Provides</u> you with wealth, He <u>Fully Expects</u> you to <u>Invest</u> what He's Given you, in <u>His Work</u> .
